

## Prerequisite Requirements

- Calculus one course with a minimum of 3 semester units or 4 quarter units
- Statistics one course with a minimum of 3 semester units or 4 quarter units
- General Chemistry with labs a minimum of two semester courses or three quarter courses for a total of at least 8 semester units or 12 quarter units
- Organic Chemistry (no lab required) a minimum of one course for a total of at least 3 semester units or 4 quarter units.
- Biochemistry (no lab required) one course with a minimum of 3 semester units or 4 quarter units.
- General Physics with labs a minimum of two semester courses or three quarter courses for a total of at least 8 semester units or 12 quarter units.
- General Biology or Zoology (no labs required) a minimum of two semester courses or three quarter courses for a total of at least 6 semester units or 9 quarter units
- General Microbiology/Bacteriology with lab one course with a minimum of 3 semester units or 4 quarter units
- Human Anatomy (no lab required) one course with a minimum of 3 semester units or 4 quarter units
- Human Physiology (no lab required) one course with a minimum of 3 semester units or 4 quarter units
- General Psychology one course with a minimum of 3 semester units or 4 quarter units
- English Composition/Literature two courses for a total of 6 semester units or 8 quarter units

## **General Information:**

- Bachelor's Degree: A four-year baccalaureate degree is recommended; however, applicants who complete a minimum of 90 semester or 135 quarter units of undergraduate study will qualify for admission. To be eligible to apply, the applicant must be on track to complete the required units through the summer term that precedes fall matriculation.
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses for the prerequisites will be accepted as long as the appropriate number of credit hours was
  received. These courses must appear on your official college transcript or in a letter from the registrar stating that the appropriate
  number of credit hours was verified by the program.
- Any psychology course offered by the Psychology Department is acceptable to meet the requirement.
- Human Anatomy and Physiology (A&P) prerequisite requirement:
  - A&P may be completed as A&P I and A&P II or as individual courses (human anatomy and human physiology) for a minimum total of 6 semester units or 8 quarter units.
  - Animal or vertebrate physiology may be substituted for human physiology; however, there is no substitute for human anatomy.
- Any course offered by the English Department or writing intensive course (classified as "WI" on a transcript) will meet the prerequisite requirement.
- Online course policy:
  - Lecture courses may be completed in the online format from a regionally accredited institution
  - o Lab courses may not be completed online
- Students may apply with prerequisite coursework in progress; however, all prerequisite requirements must be completed before MBKU's fall term begins (mid-August). Courses below must be completed with a grade of "C-" or better.
