

The academic gowns that you see today represent a tradition that we inherited from the universities of the Middle Ages. Those institutions were founded by the church; and the students, being clerics, were obliged to wear their clerical gowns and caps at all times. Through the ages, these regalia were altered to accommodate both fashion and fancy.

In the United States, academic gowns are usually black, but the way they are worn and their cut distinguishes the wearer's academic degree. The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's and doctor's gown may be worn open or closed. Also, the sleeves of the gowns are shaped differently according to the level of degree: a bachelor's gown has long, pointed sleeves; a master's gown has oblong sleeves that are square in the back and have an arc cut away in the front; and a doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves. In addition, velvet panels and chevrons, either in black or the color representing the academic discipline, distinguish doctoral gowns.

The mortarboards or tams for all degree holders are black. The tassels attached to the mortarboards can be black, the color that the individual academic disciplines choose to represent their field, or in the case of faculty, gold. The hood is the most outstanding and colorful feature of the regalia. It is lined with the colors of the institution from which the wearers received their degrees. Its size and shape indicate the wearer's degree; and its collar is the color of the academic discipline.

Kelly green is the color used by Physician Assistant. Optometry wears seafoam green. Pharmacy uses khaki green. The colors are used for both the tassel and the velvet trim on the hood. The purple and gold satin lining of the hood represents the traditional colors of Marshall B. Ketchum University.

Along with the degree holder being identified by gown style and hood color, the holder is further identified by his place in the procession. Those having the highest faculty seniority are always positioned at the end of the processional.

UNIVERSITY MACE

Colleges and universities often employ a "mace" to connect the institution's customs with the best traditions of higher education dating to the first universities founded during the Middle Ages. A mace symbolizes authority, learning and scholarship, history, reputation and values. It suggests commemoration, elegance, honor, pageantry, purpose, quality, solemnity, stability and continuity.

Dr. Mabee holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology from The University of The State of New York, a Physician Assistant Certificate from Northeastern University, a Certificate of Completion - Physician Assistant Residency in Emergency Medicine at the Los Angeles County-University of Southern California (LAC-USC) Medical

Center, a Master of Science degree in Biology from California State University, Los Angeles, and a PhD in Biomedical Sciences from The Union Institute and University. He has over 20 years of experience as a clinically practicing Physician Assistant, 17 of which were spent at LAC-USC Medical Center in emergency medicine serving the needs of a diverse, medically underserved population. In 2001, he joined the Keck School of Medicine of USC Physician Assistant program as a full-time faculty member, and retired in 2015 after 14 years as a Physician Assistant educator. In retirement, he has continued to intermittently work as a medical educator in an online learning platform with Hippo Education, and here at Marshall B. Ketchum University's Physician Assistant program where he has received the annual Outstanding Clinical Lecturer Award numerous times. His academic experience includes teaching at the college and professional school level, bench-side laboratory research, and clinical investigations involving human subjects. Dr. Mabee has 19 peerreviewed publications, 8 abstracts, and has received multiple invitations to lecture at professional conferences. He has also served as a test item writer for the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA) for 15 years. For ten of those years, he chaired a test-writing committee for the Physician Assistant National Recertification Examination (PANRE). Additionally, he also served as chair of the test-writing committee for NCCPA's certificate of added qualification (CAQ) examination in Orthopaedic Surgery for four years. His personal interests include music and Tae Kwon Do, where he holds the rank of 4th degree black belt (Tae Kwon Do master).


















I PLEDGE TO PERFORM THE FOLLOWING DUTIES WITH HONESTY AND DEDICATION:
