MBKU is committed to excellent teaching, state-of-the-art research and academic facilities as well as the personal and intellectual growth of our students.























STUDENTS AND FACULTY PLAY AN ACTIVE ROLE IN SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH.

Marshall B. Ketchum University is leading a momentous change in health care education.


This change breaks down the traditional silos between different professional programs so students understand, on a comprehensive level, how to deliver excellent patient care in a team environment.
