

BEVERLY BIANES, OD, '91



Beverly Bianes, OD, '91 and her husband, Dr. John Pack, '91 practice with their daughter, Dr. Alyssa Pack, '20 in San Diego. While an actively practicing optometrist, Dr. Bianes is also widely recognized within the optometry field for her contributions to women in leadership roles as well as her community service, both domestically and abroad. She has won several industry awards and serves on the boards of optometric organizations such as Women in Optometry, Optometry Divas, Optical Women's Association, San Diego County Optometry Society, and the Transitions Diversity Advisory Board. In 2021, she was named as one of the Most Influential Women in Optical for her program Neighbors Helping Neighbors, an initiative that allows the local community to nominate neighbors impacted by COVID-19 to receive free exams and glasses. Her community service also expands to issues such as supporting homeless transitional adult youth, embracing cultural diversity, and supporting women.

JERRY R. PAUGH, OD, PHD



Dr. Paugh completed his OD and MSc degrees at the Ohio State University College of Optometry, and a later PhD at the University of New South Wales in Sydney Australia.

He has conducted numerous research studies, concentrating on the diagnosis and management of dry eye, the use of fluorometry to examine epithelial barrier function, formulation residence time, and drug delivery, and the effects of contact lenses on corneal health.

Dr. Paugh is currently Professor and Associate Dean for Research at the Southern California College of Optometry in Fullerton, California, USA, where he teaches biostatistics and contact lenses. He has authored more than 24 peer-reviewed papers, published three book chapters, holds two patents, and has lectured worldwide on various clinical and academic topics. Dr. Paugh is a Diplomate in the American Academy of Optometry Cornea and Contact

Lens section and has recently been awarded the Hemenger Faculty Research Award at SCCO.

The Southern California College of Optometry, through the generosity of alumni and community benefactors over many decades, is able to offer more than 170 scholarships and awards to our students each fall and spring. A C A D E M I C R E G A L I A



The academic gowns that you see today represent a tradition that we inherited from the universities of the Middle Ages. Those institutions were founded by the church; and the students, being clerics, were obliged to wear their clerical gowns and caps at all times. Through the ages, these regalia were altered to accommodate both fashion and fancy.

In the United States, academic gowns are usually black, but the way they are worn and their cut distinguishes the wearer's academic degree. The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's and doctor's gown may be worn open or closed. Also, the sleeves of the gowns are shaped differently according to the level of degree: a bachelor's gown has long, pointed sleeves; a master's gown has oblong sleeves that are square in the back and have an arc cut away in the front; and a doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves. In addition, velvet panels and chevrons, either in black or the color representing the academic discipline, distinguish doctoral gowns.

The mortarboards or tams for all degree holders are black. The tassels attached to the mortarboards can be black, the color that the individual academic disciplines choose to represent their field, or in the case of faculty, gold. The hood is the most outstanding and colorful feature of the regalia. It is lined with the colors of the institution from which the wearers received their degrees. Its size and shape indicate the wearer's degree; and its collar is the color of the academic discipline.

Kelly green is the color used by Physician Assistant. Optometry wears seafoam green. Pharmacy uses khaki green. The colors are used for both the tassel and the velvet trim on the hood. The purple and gold satin lining of the hood represents the traditional colors of Marshall B. Ketchum University.

Along with the degree holder being identified by gown style and hood color, the holder is further identified by his place in the procession. Those having the highest faculty seniority are always positioned at the end of the processional.

UNIVERSITY MACE

Colleges and universities often employ a "mace" to connect the institution's customs with the best traditions of higher education dating to the first universities founded during the Middle Ages. A mace symbolizes authority, learning and scholarship, history, reputation and values. It suggests commemoration, elegance, honor, pageantry, purpose, quality, solemnity, stability and continuity.
