JOB SUMMARY

The role of a Didactic faculty member is to coordinate and teach modules and lectures involved with the academic curriculum, participate in patient assessment workshops and clinical skills workshops, advise/evaluate students, and represent the school to the medical and Marshall B. Ketchum University community.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Coordinates, teaches and evaluates the effectiveness of assigned courses and modules during the didactic portion of the curriculum.
- 2. Prepares lectures/presentations and student assessments for assigned modules.
- 3. Participates in training and evaluation of students in physical exam workshops, laboratory and clinical skills sessions.
- 4. Serves as the Academic Advisor to students throughout the program.
- 5. Assists with ongoing program assessment and data analysis for accreditation.
- 6. Serves on College of Health Sciences and University committees as requested/appointed.
- 7. Carries out scholarly and professional activities that contribute to the school/profession and personal professional development.
- 8. Participates as clinician at community health fairs, interprofessional clinics, and other outreach projects supervising PA students as requested.
- 9. Other duties as assigned by the Director of Didactic Education or Director.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Certified Physician Assistant eligible for license in California.
- 2. Master's degree or higher.
- 3. Minimum of 3 years clinical experience (>5 preferred) as a physician assistant. Previous teaching and/or administrative experience is preferred.
- 4. Excellent communication and problem solving skills.
- 5. Engages in open, collaborative and collegial interactions with others.
- 6. Demonstrated leadership skills with ability to motivate students to achieve goals and objectives.
- 7. Advanced ability to use microcomputer systems and at a minimum: PowerPoint®, Excel®, and Microsoft Word®.
