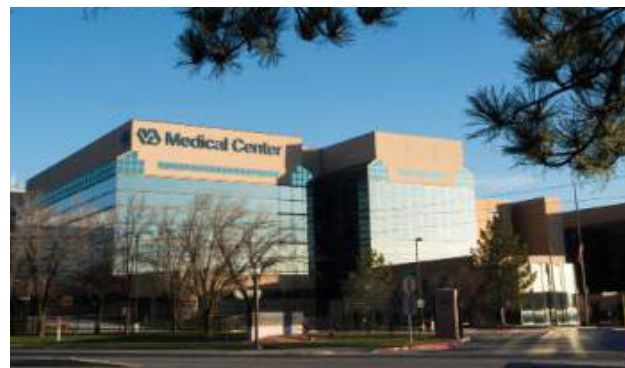

GENERAL SELECTION CRITERIA

All official documents including transcripts, board scores, letter of recommendations and letter of intent should be sent directly to the program coordinator at the specific residency program site. The program coordinator evaluates all completed applications prior to ORMatch day. A ranking order will be identified and provided to ORMatch. The name of the matching applicant will be provided to the MBKU Assistant Dean of Residencies, which will then make a recommendation for appointment of the selected to the Dean of Optometry. The matched applicant is then offered a written contract from MBKU for the residency position. Approximate weights are placed on each by the Residency Coordinator, which are as follows:

- Interview
- GPA
- NBEO scores
- Letter of Intent
- Letter of Recommendations
- Special qualities / characteristics
 - Maturity
 - Professionalism
 - Communications skills
 - Attitude
 - Ability to get along with others

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR RESIDENCY COMPLETION

- The resident is required to keep and report a detailed log of all program activities to include, but not necessarily limited to, Patient Encounter and Diagnosis Log, Faculty Evaluation, Resident Referral Log, Resident Activity Log, Resident Reading Log and Final Evaluation of Residency Program. The MBKU Assistant Dean of Residencies and the Program Coordinator will review all submitted documents for completeness and insure that all criteria are satisfactorily met.
- The resident is required to provide patient care services at a level deemed satisfactory to the Program Coordinator and faculty, in line with the highest levels of current optometric standards of practice.
- The resident is required to submit a paper based upon original research, literature review and/or clinical case or cases suitable for publication in a peer reviewed optometric journal.
- The resident is expected to deliver patient care services in a professional manner and to observe those proprieties of conduct and courtesy that are consistent with the rules and regulations governing MBKU and the specific program.



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
