SUMMARY

The Director for School of Physician Assistant Studies will be responsible for the effective leadership and management of the School, which includes:

STRATEGIC LEADERSHIP

- · Responsible for School organization and administration.
- Provide direction in strategic planning with stakeholders to further the School's mission in teaching, scholarship, service, and patient care.
- Collaborate with the University administration to increase funding for School operations, growth, and scholarships.
- Develop and monitor the annual budget to ensure resources are allocated appropriately for the School's operation.
- · Guide the student admissions process in collaboration with Enrollment and Student Services
- Supervise School personnel and the ongoing recruitment of faculty, staff, clinical sites, and preceptors, as well as retention efforts and professional development for faculty.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM OVERSIGHT

- · Lead the faculty in developing and revising the School's mission, goals, and competencies.
- Participate in and guide didactic and clinical phase curriculum development and student instruction.
- Supervise the processes for academic and professional performance evaluation, remedial instruction, and academic counseling of students.
- Collaborate with the faculty to conduct continuous program review, analysis, planning, and development.
- Conduct accurate and timely completion of required accreditation documents and ongoing adherence to the ARC-PA Standards.
