- Candidates are required to have Ph.D., or equivalent degree, relevant training (postdoctoral/residency), and expertise primarily in the area of pharmacology.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Demonstrate ethical conduct, professionalism, interpersonal and leadership skills, and management abilities.
- Prior teaching experience in integrated curriculum and team-based learning in Pharmacy or healthcare related programs and implementation of active learning techniques in a classroom environment will be an asset.
- Candidates are also expected to demonstrate active involvement in research/scholarly and service activities.
