This is a full-time, 12-month, faculty position at the ranks of Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor. All Clinical Specialties are encouraged to apply. The College seeks forward-thinking faculty candidate with a commitment to excellence in teaching, practice, and research. The faculty member reports directly to the Department Chair of Pharmacy Practice. Successful candidates must demonstrate the ability to clearly articulate ideas, achieve shared goals, and possess strong interpersonal skills. Responsibilities may include, but are not limited to, establishing a clinical practice site and providing clinical services, precepting IPPE and APPE students, and mentoring pharmacy students in projects. Teaching responsibilities include course coordination and instruction, developing and implementing effective didactic lectures and active learning techniques and engagement. The successful applicant will also support College research initiatives and participate in service activities of the Department, College, and University. Candidates should have a terminal degree (PharmD or equivalent) and PGY1 residency training. Preference will be given to candidates with PGY2 and/or fellowship training, board certification, other credentialing, and/or previous academic experience.
