President, National Optometric Association NSU Associate Professor & Chief of Advance Care Clinic

Dr. Sherrol A. Reynolds received a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Florida and attended NSU College of Optometry where she earned her Doctor of Optometry in 1996 and pursued a residency in primary care optometry.

She recently rejoined the faculty at NSU College of Optometry after being there for nearly twenty years. Prior to returning she was an optometric liaison for Your Eye Specialist working alongside noted glaucoma, retina and cornea specialists for about one-year. She is a Fellow in the American Academy of Optometry and the Optometric Retinal Society. She has been involved in numerous research and publications on ocular disease.

Apart from her passion in academia, Dr. Reynolds serves as the current President of the National Optometric Association (NOA). She was awarded the National Optometric Association (NOA) Optometrist of the Year in 2013. She also serves as chair of the Florida Optometric Association Healthy Eye Healthy People committee and the NOA's liaison to the National Eye Institute (NEI) National Eye Health Education Program (NEHEP). And, she serves as a volunteer member of the Prevent Blindness Scientific Advisory Committee. She has served as a monthly columnist for the Optometric Management Journal, Retina Column for the past three years.

Dr. Reynolds spends a great deal of time giving back to the community. She helped coordinate a number of community service events in underserved communities and participated in the NSU Jamaica Medical Mission trip, an international outreach mission to underserved communities in rural Jamaica, for the past fifteen years. She also mentors at risk high school students in Broward county through the Women of Tomorrow (WOT) mentoring and scholarship program for over ten years.

The academic gowns that you see today represent a tradition that we inherited from the universities of the Middle Ages. Those institutions were founded by the church; and the students, being clerics, were obliged to wear their clerical gowns and caps at all times. Through the ages, these regalia were altered to accommodate both fashion and fancy.

In the United States, academic gowns are usually black, but the way they are worn and their cut distinguishes the wearer's academic degree. The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's and doctor's gown may be worn open or closed. Also, the sleeves of the gowns are shaped differently according to the level of degree: a bachelor's gown has long, pointed sleeves; a master's gown has oblong sleeves that are square in the back and have an arc cut away in the front; and a doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves. In addition, velvet panels and chevrons, either in black or the color representing the academic discipline, distinguish doctoral gowns.

The mortarboards or tams for all degree holders are black. The tassels attached to the mortarboards can be black, the color that the individual academic disciplines choose to represent their field, or in the case of faculty, gold. The hood is the most outstanding and colorful feature of the regalia. It is lined with the colors of the institution from which the wearers received their degrees.

Its size and shape indicate the wearer's degree; and its collar is the color of the academic discipline.

Students academic achievement at graduation with the Latin Honor System based on final grades at the end of the third professional year. Students who achieved Cum Laude status earned a grade point average of 3.40 to 3.59. They are wearing white honor cords. Students who earned Magna Cum Laude status had a grade point average of 3.60 to 3.79 and are wearing silver honor cords. Students who earned Summa Cum Laude status had a grade point average of 3.80 to 4.0 and wear gold honor cords.

Optometry is represented by the color sea foam green. The PAs wear kelly green. Pharmacy uses olive green. The colors are used for both the tassel and the velvet trim on the hood. The purple and gold satin lining of the hood represents the traditional colors of Marshall B. Ketchum University.

Along with the degree holder being identified by gown style and hood color, the holder is further identified by their place in the procession. Those having the highest faculty seniority are always positioned at the end of the processional.

UNIVERSITY MACE

Colleges and universities often employ a "mace" to connect the institution's customs with the best traditions of higher education dating to the first universities founded during the Middle Ages. A mace symbolizes authority, learning and scholarship, history, reputation and values. It suggests commemoration, elegance, honor, pageantry, purpose, quality, solemnity, stability and continuity.
